Psalm 72

Your sewer backs up. I've got a guy for that. Your furnace breaks down. I've got a guy for that. Your stove, your oven won't work. I've got a guy for that. When something goes wrong, even before it goes wrong, what a relief to know - you have a guy for that. But it gets better.

Your world goes bad; you're wronged, and you need some justice. I've got a guy for that. You go bad; you're wrong, and you need relief from justice. I've got a guy for that. You're feeling squeezed, crushed; you're being torn into, ripped apart. I've got a guy for that. Your guy for this or that doesn't answer. Your guy for this or that drops the ball, falls short, turns out to be a fake and a fraud. I've got a guy for that. You're facing a world of chaos and high anxiety. Put all of that together; I've even got a guy for that.

I imagine you might have a voice inside your head saying: "yea, but." Yea, but - if he's like most all the other guys I've called when I need help, he's probably out of business. Well, no, he hasn't gone out of business. You don't need to worry; he won't go out of business -

He will endure as long as the sun, as long as the moon, through all generations.

Yea, but - I'm probably outside of his service zone; he probably just helps those other people over there. No, you're not outside his service zone. When you need help, you don't have to worry; he's not just the guy for those people over there.

He will rule from sea to sea

and from the River to the ends of the earth.

Yea, but - he might have what it takes to help you with your problems, but he can't have what it takes to help me with my problems. You have big problems? You need help in a big way? You need a guy with resources? You don't need to worry. My guy has the riches of the world; my guy has all the resources of the world.

The kings of Tarshish and of distant shores will bring tribute to him; the kings of Sheba and Seba will present him gifts.

Yea, but - have you seen what's going on in the world - hurricanes and floods, wars and more wars coming, the elections When you need help and it seems like the world is against you ... when you need help and it seems the world is out of control You don't need to worry; he's the guy you need. He will rule; he will have his way -

All kings will bow down to him and all nations will serve him.

Yea, but - he's probably too busy. With all that's going on, he's probably overwhelmed with service calls, overwhelmed by too many calls for help. With all that's going on he, probably doesn't see me, hear me, remember me. With all that's going on, he can't possibly help everyone. You don't need to worry. Even with all that's going on, he won't be overwhelmed -

All nations will be blessed through him, and they will call him blessed.

It doesn't matter what you have going, my guy will be ready for you. He will be up to whatever you bring him. If this world treats you wrong, my guy has justice for you. "Yea, but" No "yea,

buts." If anybody gets in his way, he'll have them licking the dust. **He will crush the oppressor.** And not only that, when he works his justice, the wronged will be made right. The cheated will be made whole. The hurt will be healed.

How about this testimonial? "He [is] like rain falling on a mown field." I know that's not a good October picture, but picture a field of grass, cut, slashed with a sickle on a hot, dry day. The grass is beaten, bruised, cut apart, torn apart. Ever feel like that grass, your heart beaten, bruised, torn apart? And then a cool, soothing rain falls on the grass cooling, soothing, healing - and the brown grass turns green, the dead grass comes to life. That's what my guy can do for you. If you've been wronged, you can be sure of this, my guy will make your life right. He will surround you with life made right.

Picture hills and mountains full of life - the greenest pastures, vineyards loaded with grapes - a farmer, a shepherd, a vintner would say it's a picture of heaven - all for you! Or maybe sheep and goats and grapes and olives aren't your thing. Picture a cabin, a house on a lake in the woods up north - quiet and peaceful. Picture your favorite beach with the sun coming up - a beautiful day coming. Or this ... I know some of you are looking forward to snow-covered mountains bright and beautiful, covered with fresh powder; hills dotted with ski lodges. Imagine you're set up in one of those lodges, a beautiful mountain view off your deck - wow!, a roaring fireplace keeping you warm inside - ah! Imagine a day, a life, of wow and ah - yes, imagine heaven for you! This world might seem so wrong; this world might treat you so wrong; but my guy will work justice for you. He will set you up right - as right as heaven!

Yea, but - but what if you are the one who did wrong? And your excuses aren't working. And blaming others isn't working. And

you can't do enough right to make up for your wrong. And the thought of justice doesn't give you hope, but the thought of justice hangs over your head like a curse. My guy has what you need. He has this deal with the judge. He worked it out long ago. He worked it out that he would take the blame for my wrong, for your wrong. He would pay the price for our wrong. He would be crushed and cursed for our wrong. And then he would cover over our wrong with his right. That's what my guy did for me. That's what your guy did for you. When we're wrong, we don't need to be afraid of justice. We've got a guy who has set us right with the justice of heaven.

So who is my guy? You noticed he's no ordinary guy. He's a king, not a dress-up, pretend king, but a ruling king. A king who rules around the world; a king who is worshiped around the world. A king who rules for all time; a king who rules for all people. So he's no ordinary guy. And he's no ordinary King; he's God's King. He's the Guy we need when the world wrongs us. He's the Guy we need when we're wrong. He's the Guy we need when the world rips into us. He's the Guy we need when no one else will answer. Who is he? He's my Guy from God; he's your Guy from God. He's Jesus Christ. God's Guy, God's King for you! Amen.

Jesus said, "My kingdom is not of this world. If it were, my servants would fight to prevent my arrest by the Jewish leaders. But now my kingdom is from another place."





NICENE CREED

Hear our prayer.




LORD'S PRAYER
